It also features a Wellness Centre to care for the emotional, spiritual and social needs of our patients and carers. The Wellness Centre offers relaxation and well-being therapies, a library, kitchen, lounge, internet access and children's play area.

### Leave a bequest

After providing for those closest to you in your Will, please consider leaving a bequest to the Ballarat Regional Integrated Cancer Centre (BRICC).

The BRICC, which includes a Wellness Centre, opened in 2013, and is extending visiting cancer services to other towns in the Grampians region.

This has completely transformed the way in which we care for our patients, making it possible for them to remain close to home, family and friends while undergoing treatment. This support is vital, as experience has shown that complete care of a patient means looking after more than their medical needs.

With thousands of people diagnosed in our region each year, it is almost certain that you will know someone who needs the BRICCs' help at some point in their life.

It could be a parent, sibling or cousin; friend, neighbour or handyman; your hairdresser or mechanic. It could even be you.

By remembering the BRICC in your Will, your generosity will help make a difference to the lives of those close to you, as well as generations to come.

Any consideration you can make to the Ballarat Regional Integrated Cancer Centre in your Will, large or small, is greatly appreciated.

On the strength of many generous community contributions combined, BRICC can plan ahead and proceed with confidence in our continued delivery of internationally recognized treatment and life-changing research.

### Steps in leaving a bequest

- > See a solicitor to draw up your Will, or review your existing Will.
- > Choose the type of gift you might like to leave, including:
  - Residuary bequest: The best type of bequest to leave the BRICC is a residuary bequest – which is a percentage of your estate. A residuary bequest maintains its value over time.
  - Specific items of value: Anything of value, such as shares, property, jewellery or works of art, may be named in your Will and bequeathed directly to the BRICC.
  - Dollar amount: You nominate an exact dollar amount to gift to the BRICC.
- > Discuss with your solicitor the appropriate wording for your Will, for example, "I devise and bequeath the whole of my estate (or...% of my estate, or the residue of my estate... whichever appropriate) to the Ballarat Regional Integrated Cancer Centre, Ballarat Health Services, Drummond St North, Ballarat 3350.
- > Discuss your wishes with your family.
- > Inform us of your gift. If you have included the BRICC in your Will, or are considering doing so, please let us know by completing and returning the form on the following page.

That way, we can thank you and keep you informed of our activities. Hearing from you could also provide us with valuable feedback, and help us inspire others in our community to improve the lives of many more people affected by cancer.
